Private Rufus Henry Beavers

Company I- "Cedar Fork Rifles"

brother of Sidney, Charles G. T.

Born: 3 Feb. 1830

Occupation : Farmer

While fighting in the upper Shenandoah Valley under General Early, Beavers was captured at Halltown,

Married Louise Lewter (b. Dec. 29, 1834 - d. June 7, 1879) together they had fourteen children.

Died in 12 Mar 1909 and buried at Mt. Pisgah Baptist Church, Chatham County, NC
